Re: BRF Withdrawal Notice Pursuant to Section 13.4 of the CEA

Dear Mr. Skrivanos:

Pursuant to and in accordance with Sections 13.3 and 13.4 of the Amended and Restated Cooperative Endeavor Agreement (“CEA”) by and among Biomedical Research Foundation of Northwest Louisiana (“BRF”), BRF Hospital Holdings, L.L.C., (“BRFH”), Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College (“LSU”), and the State of Louisiana through the Division of Administration (“State”), this letter constitutes the “BRF Withdrawal Notice” as defined in the CEA. As you know, the time period for the dispute resolution process set forth in Section 13.4 of the CEA, as extended by agreement of the parties, expired at the close of business on September 21, 2015, without a cure or other resolution of the Public Purpose Breach as outlined in my June 10, 2015, letter to you. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 13.4 of the CEA BRF is required to withdraw as a member of BRFH ten (10) days from the date of this letter, or on October 5, 2015 (the “Withdrawal Date”). *Academic Health of North Louisiana Hospital Management Company, Inc., a Louisiana nonprofit corporation* will be the successor to BRF as a member of BRFH and will also be appointed to be the manager of BRFH.
