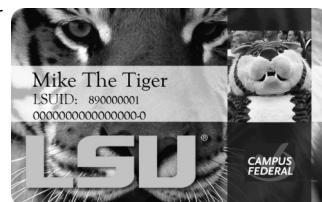

Complete the Registration process

FEE BILLS WILL NOT BE MAILED TO YOU! Once you have scheduled classes and selected additional services, your fee bill will be available online through your PAWS account. You can pay online by check or credit card. Your class schedule will be purged if not paid by **4:30 pm Friday, January 14, 2011!** **NOTE: You must be sure to complete registration even if your balance is \$0.00!** Questions about your fee bill?
