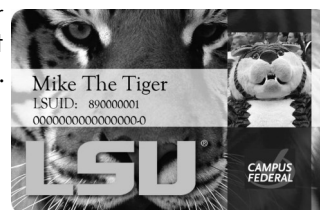

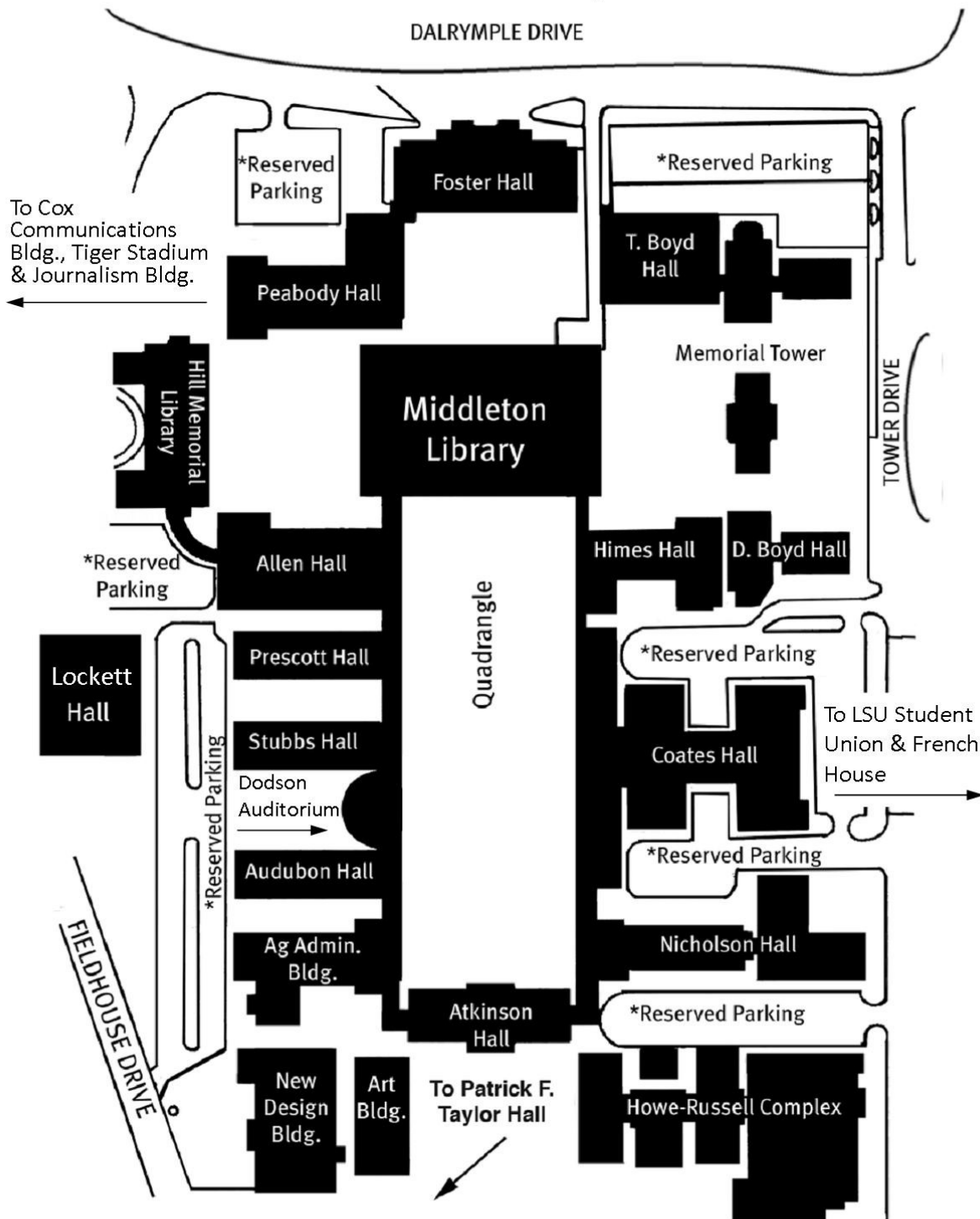
Scheduled for Sunday, August 22 (the night before classes begin). This is the only time your entire class will assemble before graduation. Don't miss out!
