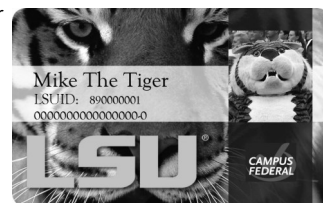

FEE BILLS WILL NOT BE MAILED TO YOU! You can pay by online check or credit card. Your class schedule will be purged if not paid by **4:30 pm Friday, June 5, 2009!**

NOTE: You must be sure to complete registration even if your balance is \$0.00!
