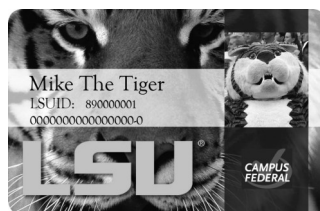

Registration is not complete until your tuition and other fees are paid. **FEE BILLS WILL NOT BE MAILED TO YOU!**

You can pay by online check or credit card. **Your class schedule will be cancelled if you have not paid tuition by 4:30 pm on Friday, August 21, 2009! BE SURE TO COMPLETE REGISTRATION EVEN IF YOUR BALANCE IS \$0.00!**

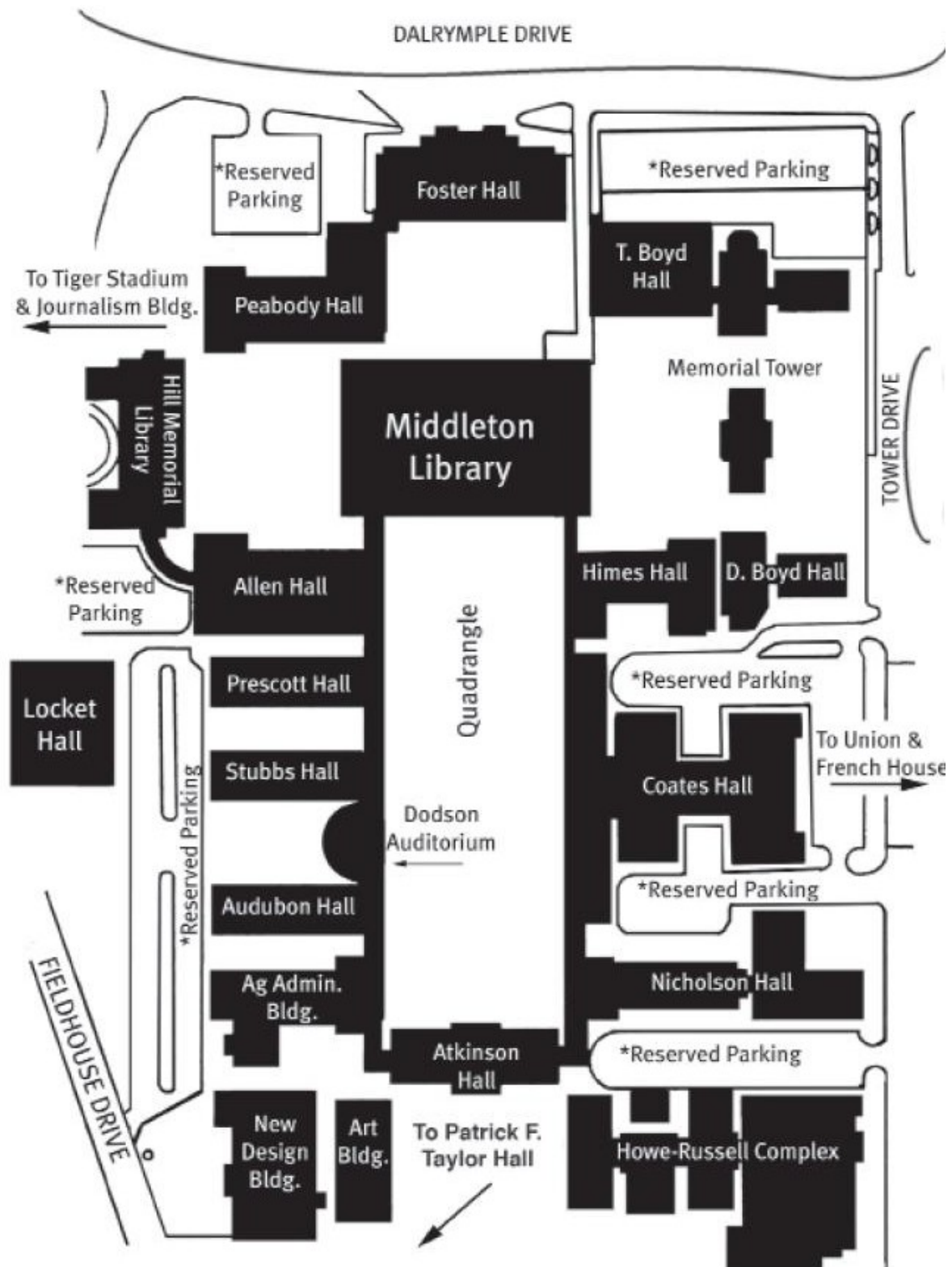
Scheduled for Sunday, August 23 (the night before classes begin). This is the only time your entire class will assemble before graduation. Don't miss out!
