Complete the Registration process

Registration is not complete until your tuition and other fees are paid. **FEE BILLS WILL NOT BE MAILED TO YOU!**

You can pay by online check or credit card. **Your class schedule will be cancelled if you have not paid tuition by 4:30 pm on August 6, 2009! BE SURE TO COMPLETE REGISTRATION EVEN IF YOUR BALANCE IS \$0.00!**
