SCHOLASTIC WARNING/SCHOLASTIC PROBATION

Any student with less than a 2.000 GPA will be identified in one of two categories of academic standing: Scholastic Warning (.1-9.9 quality points below the 2.000 average) or Scholastic Probation (10 or more quality points below the 2.000 average.) All University College students falling into these categories was sent an email at the conclusion of the semester explaining the effects of warning or probation status. This email included instructions about a required attendance at an IMPACT workshop conducted by the Center for Academic Success offered prior to the beginning of the Spring 2018 semester. The schedule for these workshops are:

Attendance is required at only one of the workshops and will be monitored by ID card swipe.

GRADE EXCLUSION POLICY

Students may improve the undergraduate LSU and cumulative GPAs by repeating a maximum of three courses (up to 12 credit hours) in which a grade of “D” or “F” was earned and requesting that the repeat grade be the only one that is used in the calculation. If a student should decide to take advantage of this policy, the process of approval requires action to be taken with an UCFY academic counselor. There is a very strict deadline to invoke the grade exclusion. **For Spring 2018, the deadline is January 22.**

SPRING 2018 IMPORTANT DATES:

January 10, 2018	First day of classes.
January 15, 2018	Martin Luther King Day holiday.
January 18, 2018	Last day to receive a 90 percent refund.
January 19, 2018	Last day to drop courses without receiving a “W” grade, 4:30 PM.
January 22, 2018	Last day to add courses for credit and making section changes and last day to invoke the Grade Exclusion Policy for Spring 2018 courses, 4:30 PM
