- Full-time faculty and graduate assistants include positions whose salaries are paid primarily by LSU (campus 1) and excludes those with a majority charge to the LSU Agriculture Center (campus 9). Employees are reported in the department which pays the major portion of their salary.

- Minority includes American Indian, Black, Hispanic, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander.
- Freshman retention and graduation rate cohorts are fall, full-time, degree-seeking new freshmen (including those continuing from the prior summer). Students are classified by intended major on the 14th class day of their entering fall term and include 'pre' majors. Retention rates reflect the percent enrolled anywhere at LSU on the second and third fall census dates.
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- Sponsored Program data is from the Sponsored Program Management system that gives departmental credit based on the project credit splits listed for each project.
- Institutional Advancement includes the cumulative contributions (cash, gifts in kind, new commitments, planned gifts) received by each college/unit. Institutional Advancement figures for Hebert Law Center included beginning 2014-15.
