



POSTING JOBS IN HANDSHAKE

RECRUIT A TIGER

Handshake is LSU's online system for job postings, on-campus and virtual interviews, along with virtual and in-person career event registrations. Through Handshake, employers may post full-time, part-time, internship, co-op, summer, and volunteer opportunities. This system is password-protected and available to LSU students, faculty, staff, and registered alumni 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It is also free to post jobs in Handshake!

Visit lsu.joinhandshake.com/employer_registrations/new and follow the instructions for creating a free Handshake account. If you already have a Handshake account, please search for and add "Louisiana State University" under the Schools tab in the left hand navigation bar.

LIST JOB VACANCIES

After logging into Handshake, go to the "Job Posting" tab to add your vacancy. All jobs will be placed in a pending status and will be approved within two business days. You will receive a notification in Handshake once your job has been approved and is viewable to LSU students and alumni.

VIRTUAL FAIRS IN HANDSHAKE

At a Handshake virtual career fair, students can learn about your organization and opportunities through 1:1 or Group Sessions. Each employer sets their own schedule of sessions for the event.

Students and employers have access to video, audio, and text-based chat during sessions, enabling the personal connection of in-person fairs in a virtual, accessible setting.



INTERVIEWING AT LSU

Held each Fall and Spring semester, our On-Campus Interviewing program connects employers to students and alumni for internships and full-time job opportunities. Interviews can be held virtually or inperson.



CONVENIENT

In-person and virtual interviews can be held in one of the 22 private interview rooms in our Recruitment Center. Additionally, employers can use the meeting platform of their choice to conduct virtual interviews.

STREAMLINED

Each step of the interview process is coordinated through Handshake which allows the employer to schedule interview dates and time slots, post a job targeting students that meet your selection criteria, receive and review student resumes, select candidates to interview, and have students sign up for interview slots


COST-EFFECTIVE


