Write true or false beside each of the following statements describing the way you study.

1. I always preview the lecture material before I go to lecture.
2. I go over my lecture notes as soon as possible after lecture to rework them and mark problem areas.
3. I try to work the homework problems without looking at the example problems or my notes from class.
4. I go to office hours or tutoring or SI regularly to discuss problems on the homework.
5. I rework all of the homework problems (without looking at an example) before the test or quiz.
6. I spend some time studying chemistry at least five days per week (outside of class time).
7. I make mnemonics for myself to help me remember facts and equations.
8. I make diagrams or draw mental pictures of the concepts discussed in class.
9. I make sure I know the information well enough to teach it to someone who doesn't understand it.
10. I rework all of the quiz and test items I have missed before the next class session.
11. I realize that I can still do well even if I have done poorly on the quizzes and tests up to this point, but only if I change my behavior
