

Library and Information Science Minor

Students who wish to minor in library and information science at the graduate level will need to obtain approval of the officially designated advisor in their major academic field. The LIS will then assign a minor advisor to advise the student of appropriate library and information science courses.

A minor in library and information science requires twelve graduate hours of courses from an ALA accredited program, at least six of which must be taken at LSU. The School will grant a minor to any holder of the master's degree from an ALA accredited program without any further course requirements.
