

Faculty Voting Rights

This policy sets the voting rights for all members of the SLIS faculty.

All members of the faculty are welcome to attend faculty meetings. Only tenure-track and tenured faculty may be included in executive sessions.

Tenure-track and tenured faculty have the right to vote on all matters of policy and procedure, including but not limited to personnel decisions and curricular decisions.

Full-time, permanent instructors have the right to vote only on matters relating to the curriculum.

Adjunct faculty, part-time, temporary instructors (including visiting faculty) and faculty emeriti may attend faculty meetings and participate, but without vote.
