Event Information

Experience the unique opportunity to perform in Tiger Stadium with the LSU Tiger Marching Band during the annual LSU Spring Football Game!

To be eligible to participate, you must be a **current** 10th – 12th grade band student who plays a woodwind, brass, or drumline (snare, tenors/quads, bass, cymbals only) instrument, or be a colorguard/flag member.

The cost to participate is **\$15**, with a pizza lunch provided. Students who register by April 7 will receive a free commemorative hat! Family and friends may attend other LSU Spring Game Festivities inside Tiger Stadium while their student(s) perform with Tiger Band.

What To Bring

- Come dressed in a white t-shirt, khaki shorts, and athletic shoes. **No flip-flops or sandals!**
- You must bring your own instrument/equipment (including drums and/or drum stands) as we unfortunately cannot provide instruments or stands. Percussionists must also provide sticks/ mallets.
- Colorguard members will not need to bring any equipment. You will only perform stand routines during the event, and all routines will be taught to you ahead of time.
- Students will receive all music via email the week before the event. We will not be able to provide physical copies of music, so please download the music ahead of time and either print it yourself or have it on your phone. You may use a personal flip folder / lyre if desired.
- Bring sunscreen and a personal water bottle!
- If you have any dietary concerns or do not want to eat pizza for lunch, please plan to bring your own meal.
