

Incipient Firefighting for Industry



Course Description

This course is designed as an introductory course for anyone working in a marine/industrial environment. This course is very basic in nature and not designed to certify anyone as a firefighter. This course is designed to prepare the student to prevent, control, and extinguish fires utilizing dry chemical and carbon dioxide extinguishers with an overview of fixed/automatic systems commonly found in the marine/industrial environment. The subject areas covered include: fire behavior, heat transfer, classes of fires, extinguishing agents, portable fire extinguishers, and field exercises which test the skills of the student to successfully extinguish a fire utilizing a portable fire extinguishers.

All students are required to furnish their own PPE. This will include hard-hat, gloves and eye protection. Proper attire must be worn at all times during the class. Long pants shall be worn at all times. T-shirts are permitted to be worn, permitted the shirt is full length (no cut-off shirts) and has a full sleeve. (Long-sleeved shirts are recommended) Tank tops are not to be worn. Open toed shoes are not permitted (safety toes are not required). Normal work attire is recommended.

All students should be in good health and must be willing to submit to medical monitoring by FETI staff. Medical monitoring will be discussed at the beginning of the class.
