2018-2019 FATHER LETTER OF NONFILING

Your 2018-2019 application for federal student aid has been selected for verification. Your father indicated on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) that he "will not file" a 2016 federal income tax return. If this information is correct, our office is required to verify that a Federal income tax return was not filed with Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Failure to submit the required document(s) will result in a delay in the processing of your aid. The student's name and LSU ID should be listed on all documents submitted.

- Submit a 2016 IRS Letter of Nonfiling dated after October 1, 2017 or later
 - May be requested online at www.irs.gov under "Get My Tax Record"
 - The online tool requires a two-step verification. You will need the following:
 - your SSN and date of birth
 - access to your email account
 - your personal account number from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and
 - a mobile phone with your name on the account.
 - Or by completing a 'Request for Transcript of Tax Return' form 4506-T
 - Verifying that item 7 is complete and the year or period is requested is 12/31/2016.
