# Factors in Presidential & Mayoral Vote: Age

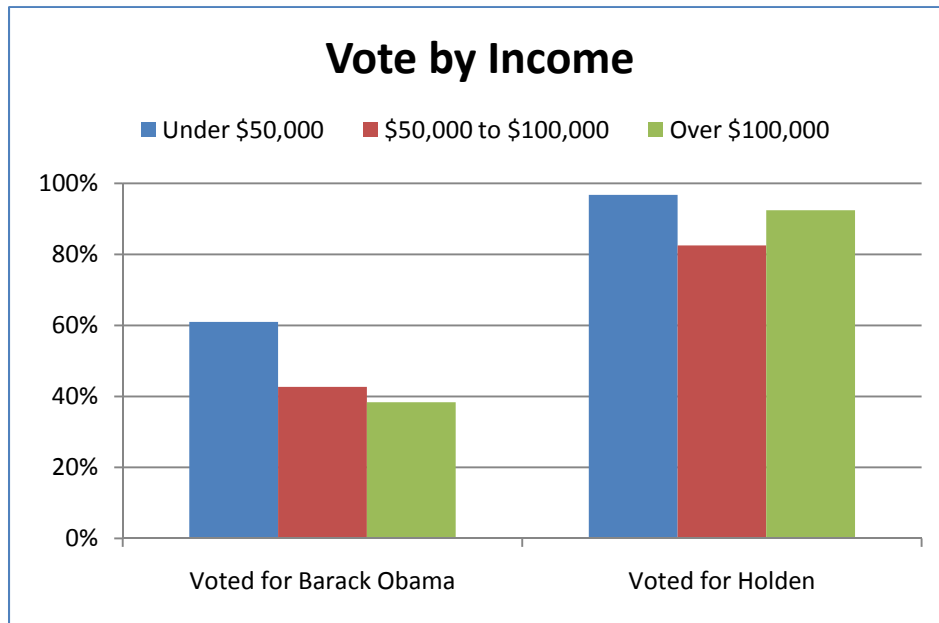




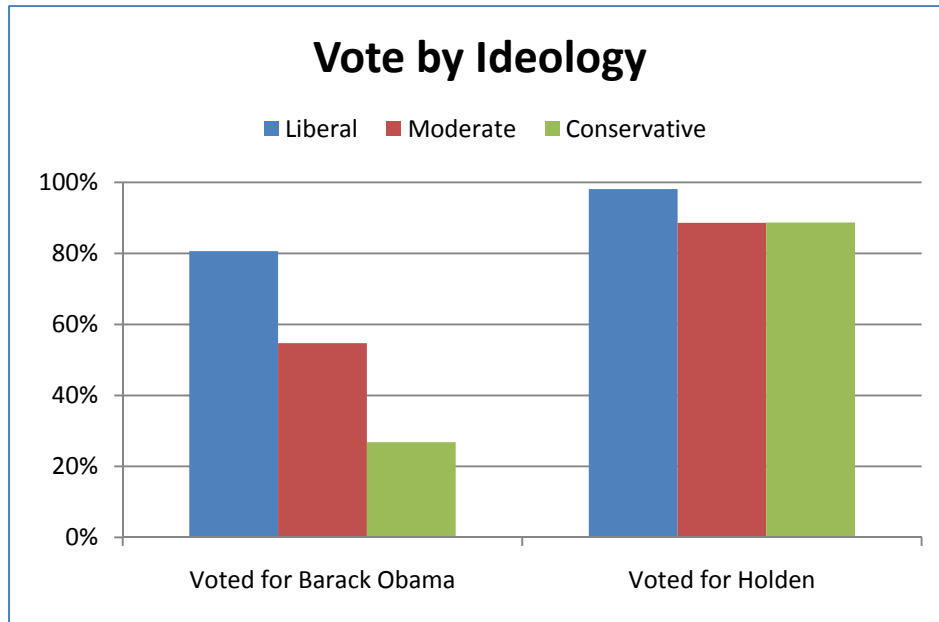
# Factors in Presidential & Mayoral Vote: Gender



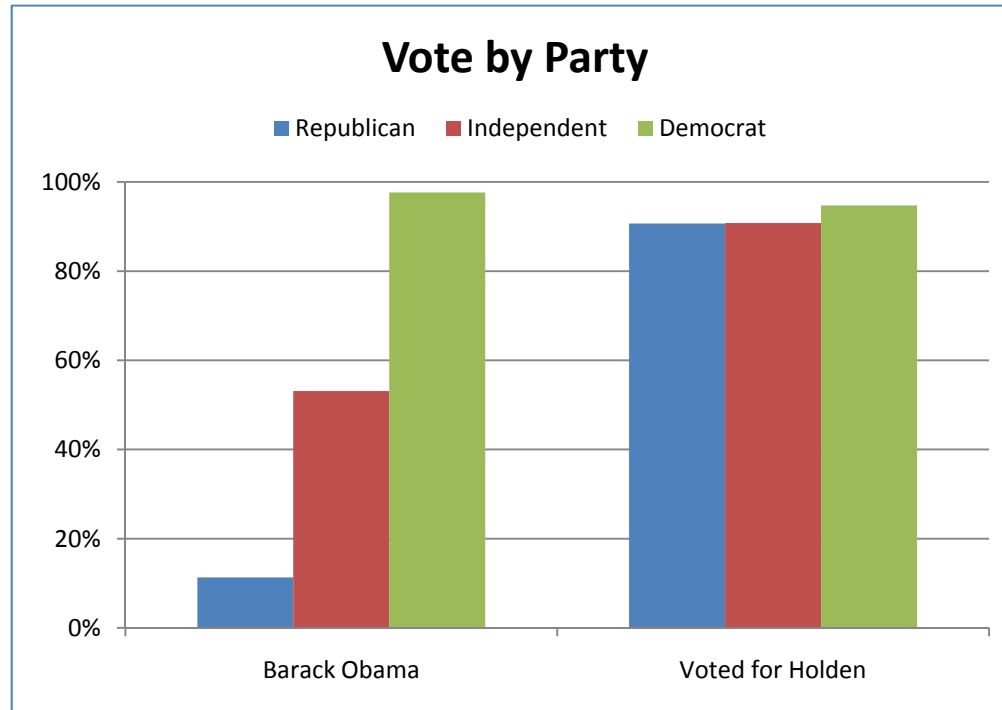

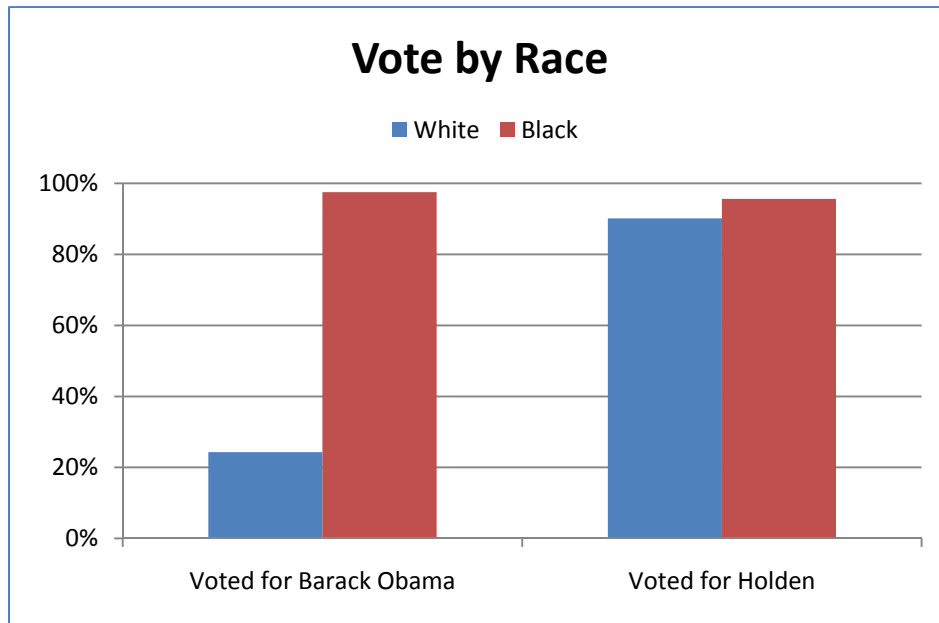

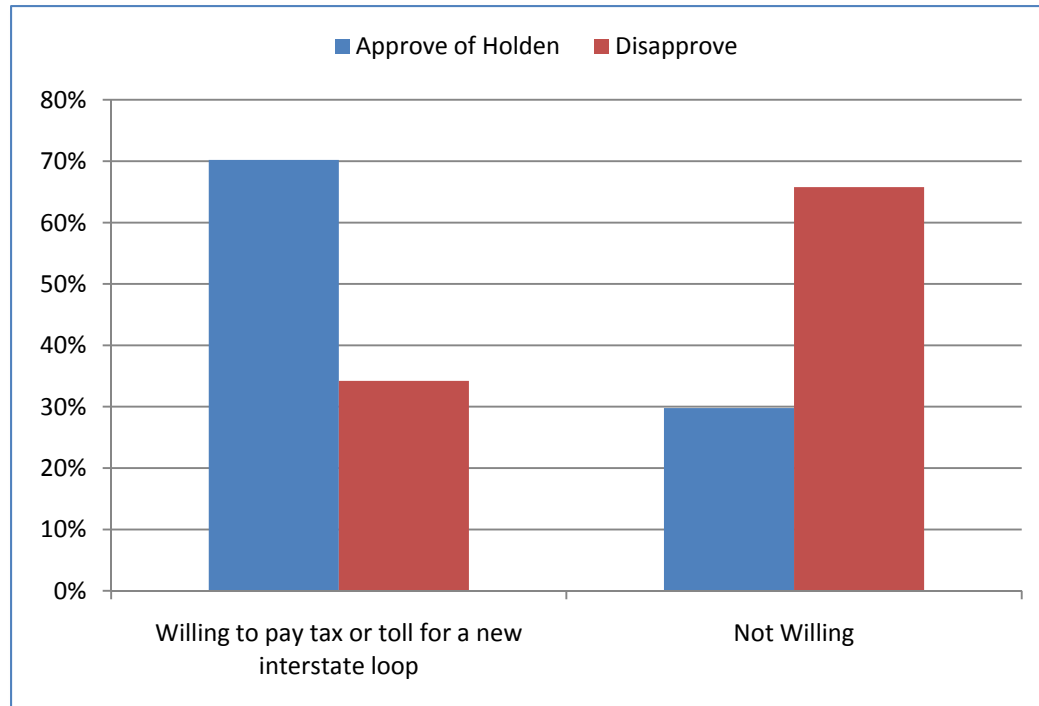


# Recognizing Traffic Congestion increases Willingness to Pay to Fix Traffic Problem

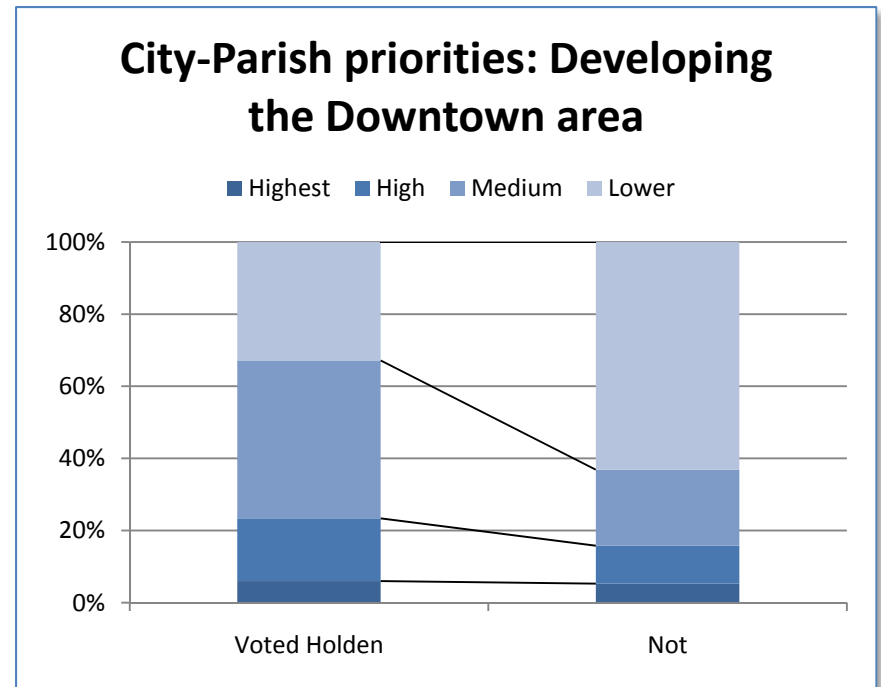
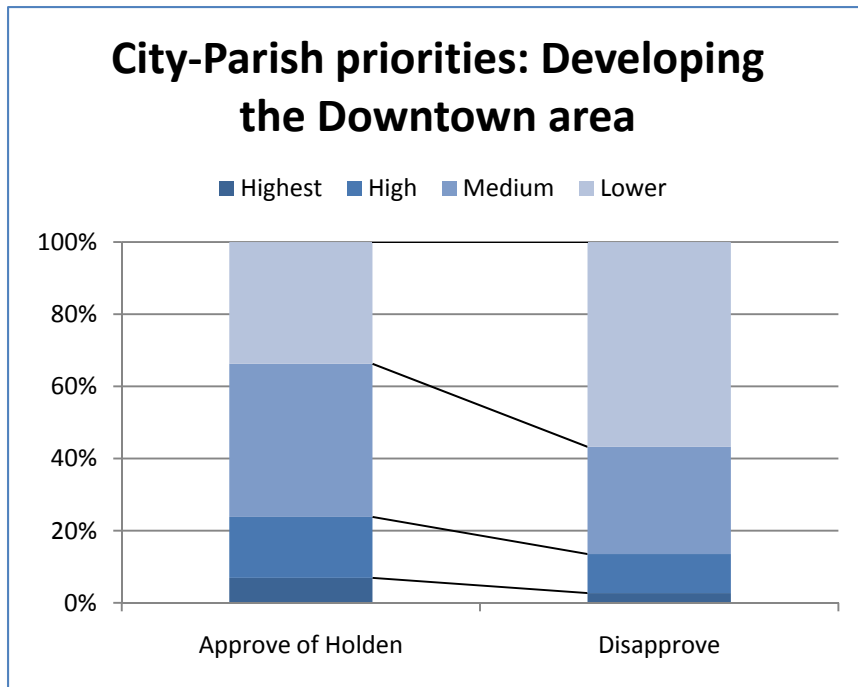




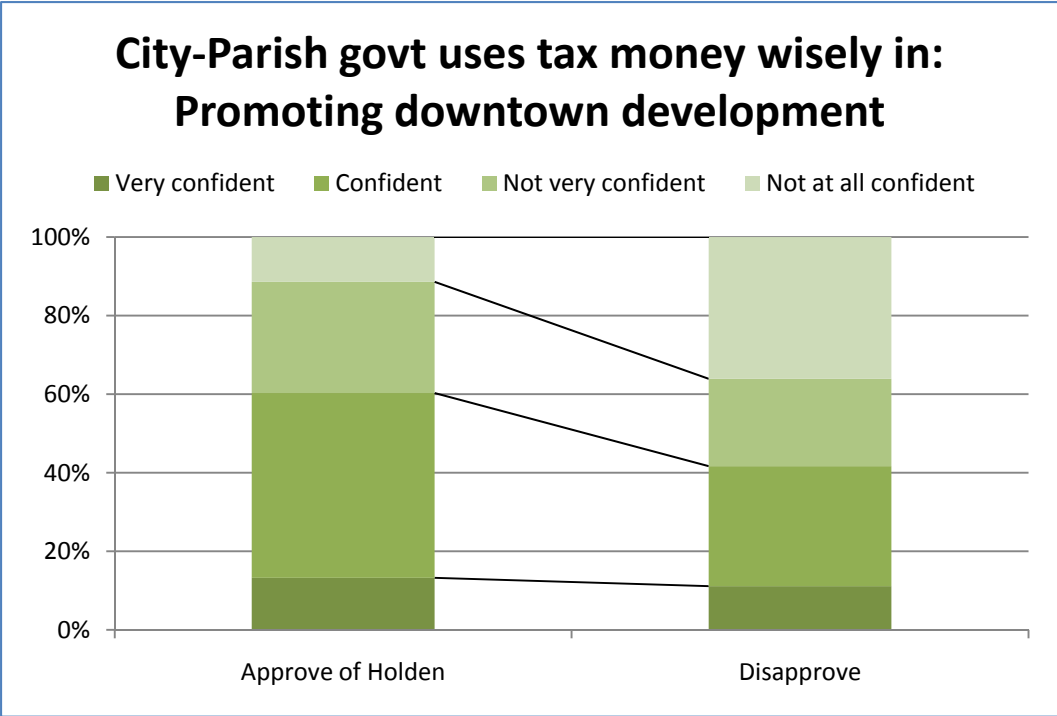

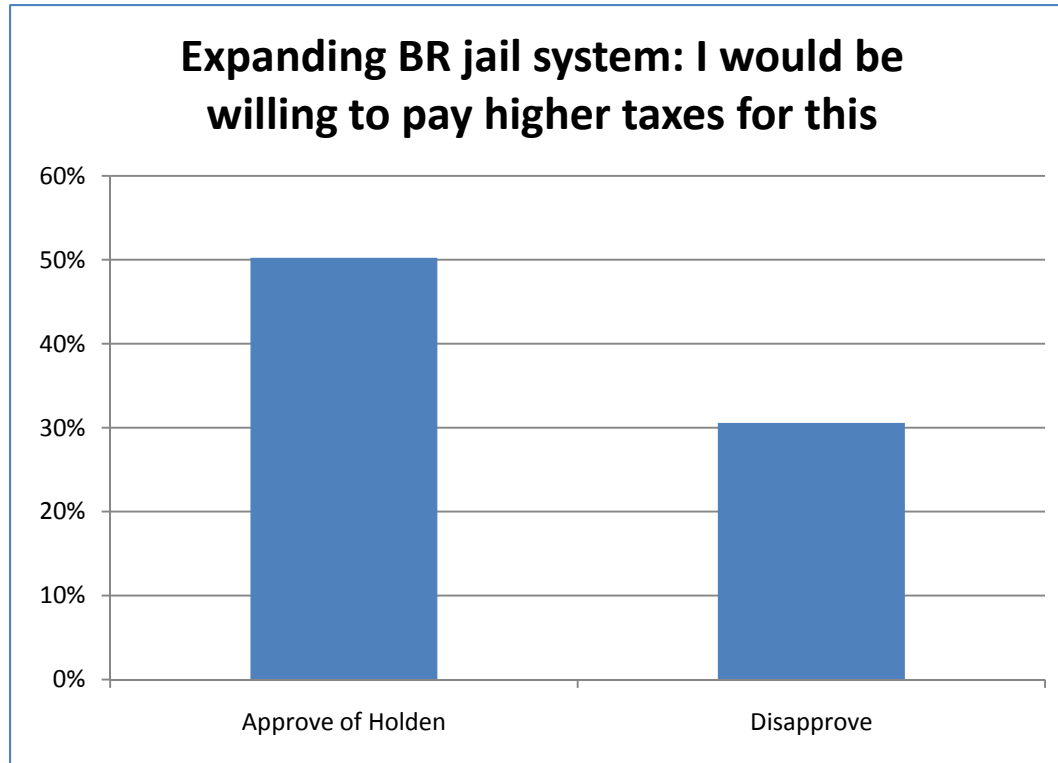
