Disability Code: According to the our *General Catalogue*, The *Office of Disability Services* assists students in identifying and developing accommodations and services to help over-come barriers to the achievement of personal and academic goals. Services are provided for students with temporary or permanent disabilities. Accommodations and services are based on the individual student's disability-based need. Students must provide current documentation of their disabilities. Students should contact the office early so that necessary accommodations can be arranged.

Attendance Policy:

Attendance matters! Students cannot expect to do their best in class if they do not attend and participate. Students with valid reasons for absence (see [PS-22](#)) are responsible "for providing reasonable advance notification and appropriate documentation of the reason for the absence" and "for making up examinations, obtaining lecture notes, and otherwise compensating for what may have been missed." Teachers "will assist those students who have valid reasons," but some in-class activities are extremely difficult to make up. [optional:] For this reason, you may drop your lowest two participation grades, but making up a third will require not one but three valid excuses.
