Starfish Parent and Child	<u>Designed for children 12 months-3 yrs old who have never been</u> exposed to swimming. The goal is to familiarize children with water and increased comfort.	5:00pm-5:30pm 5:30pm-6:00pm
<u>Seahorse</u> Preschool class	<u>Designed for children 3-5 yrs old. In</u> troduction to water skills: for children to feel comfortable in the water and safely enjoy it.	5:00pm-5:30pm 5:30pm-6:00pm 6:00pm-6:30pm
